JOB SUMMARY:

Operate radiologic equipment to make clinical diagnostic x-ray images as directed by physicians and perform routine diagnostic procedures according to established standards and practices. The Mammography Technologist performs all quality controls and maintains proper records as required. In consultation with the Interpreting Radiologist, the Mammography Technologist can designate when studies can be performed and when studies are to be temporarily cancelled due to any quality control discrepancies. The technologist will practice ethical conduct appropriate to the profession and protect the patient's right to quality radiologic technology care.
